Q1 Where do I apply for a mini electric two-wheel vehicle license plate?

A license plate can be applied for at any Motor Vehicles Office.



What documents do I need to apply Q2 for a mini electric two-wheel vehicle license plate? How much does an application cost?

The National ID or alien resident certificate (ARC) of the vehicle owner

When foreign workers buy brand new vehicles they require agreement from their employer; this does not apply to vehicles being driven

- A compulsory auto liability insurance certificate with a minimum validity of 30 days 微型電動二
 - Vehicle certificate of manufacture
- **Invoice of purchase**
- **Cost: License plate = NT\$300**

Vehicle license = NT\$150









Where does a vehicle owner purchase compulsory auto liability insurance?

Insurance can be obtained from any property insurance company.



Is there a minimum age requirement to drive a mini electric two-wheel vehicle ? Does the driver have to wear a crash helmet?

Q4

Anyone aged 14 years or older can drive a mini electric two-wheel vehicle. A crash helmet must be worn when driving.



The speed limit for mini electric two-wheel vehicle is 25km/h,can vehicles be modified to go quicker?

Q:

Modifying the electronic controller or original settings of mini electric two-wheel vehicles is strictly forbidden. Anyone found to be in violation of this provision will be fined NT\$5,400 and ordered to restore the original settings.
